## Westphalia's promising future hopes

1st Westphalian Embryo Auction with the "Who's Who" of show jumping sires

Münster: The Wesfälisches Pferdestammbuch is taking a forward-looking approach to marketing. With the first Westphalian Embryo Auction, first-class genetics of promising lines are offered. Twelve embryos are for sale in this auction. Descended from successful sires from sport-tested dam lines, all doors are open to the future hopes for breeding and sport. Bids can be submitted from July 23 to 26.

The first Westphalian Embryo Auction is also the first auction of a German breeding association with just embryos for sale. On offer are twelve embryos descending from top stallions from first-class dam lines. Six embryos are already implanted in recipient mares. Two of the embryos are carried out by their genetic mothers and four embryos are offered frozen.

Horse breeding has a long tradition in Germany. Nowadays, reproductive techniques such as embryo transfer and Ovum Pick-Up Intracytoplamsatic Sperm Injection (OPU/ICSI) are becoming more and more important. Through these procedures, sport mares can continue to compete successfully and inspire breeders with their foals. Among the sires of the offered embryos are a variety of proven sires. Chacco-Blue, Balou du Reventon and Cornet Obolensky are just a few. The embryo auction offers breeders the opportunity to expand their dam lines in order to continue breeding quality foals in the future.

Bids on the twelve embryos can be placed from July 23 to 26 at onlineauction.westfalenpferde.de. The BidUp will start on Monday evening as usual at 7.30 p.m.
